Question and Answers

Q. What about utilities that conflict with construction?

A. Utilities are required to relocate as soon as possible and as necessary so as to not impede construction and at their own cost.

Q. No quantities are included, is this project a lump sum bid?

A. Yes.

Q. Will all sub projects be awarded to one contractor?

A. Lake County reserves the right to award any and all options as part of the contract. The Department's intent is to award the project to one contractor.

Q. Do you have an estimated time for awarding the project?

A. The bid opening is scheduled for July 10, 2008, and the estimated award date is approximately 30 to 45 days thereafter. Notice of proceed is anticipated to be issued by the middle of September.

Q. Can the contractor work multiple sub-projects simultaneously?

A. Yes.
