This project is located in south Lake County in the Clermont area and entails the installation of a traffic signal on Citrus Tower Blvd at its intersection with Oakley Seaver Drive. Other work for this project shall include the following: Roadway sign installation, thermoplastic striping, and other miscellaneous incidental construction.

Items Discussed:

- When bidding, refer to the supplied "Contract Plans for Citrus Tower Blvd & Oakley Seaver Drive Intersection Improvements" FDOT FM 427481-1-58-01 dated May 2010, utilizing Tabulation of Quantities, General Notes and all plan sheets.
 - There may be adjustments to the final totals of the tabulation of quantities due to field adjustment during construction.
- Approval of submittals for all equipment is required.

- Approval of shop drawings for internally illuminated signs facing is required.
- There is a 90 day warranty for the "burn in" of all equipment. One year manufacturer's warranty on major equipment (cabinet, controller, MMU)
- Pay special attention to all the General Notes on page T-3 of the construction plans. Especially, note #3, 5, 6 and 23.
- The estimates provided on the tabulation of quantities are estimates only and shall be verified by the Contractor.
- Contractor shall bid to sod all areas disturbed by this construction.

Question and Answers:

Q. Is there an engineer's estimate for this project?

A. The estimate is \$212,000.00.

Q. Do you have an estimated time frame for project completion?

A. The contractor shall supply the numbers of days for project completion.
