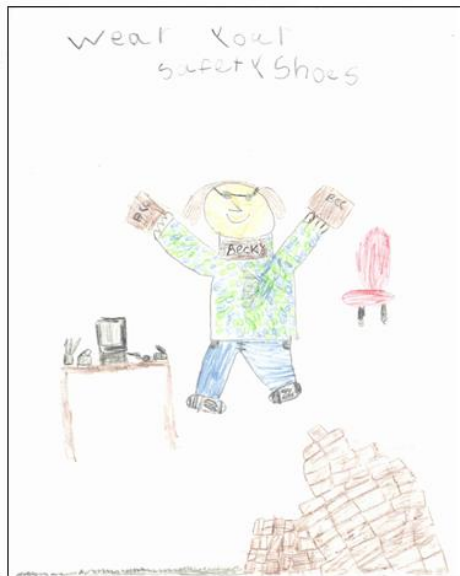
This year's North American Occupational Safety and Health Week is focusing on protecting people, property and the environment and to make sure that the millions of people who go to work each day return home safely to their families.
