

**Ordinance Summary
Music Festival Defined**

This ordinance proposes to amend Chapter II of the Lake County Land Development Regulations (LDR), entitled "Definitions", to create a definition for "music festival".

Changes are shown as follows: Underline indicates an addition to the existing Code sections. The notation "* * *" shall mean that all preceding or subsequent text remains unchanged (excluding any renumbering or relettering that might be needed).

ORDINANCE No. 2013-52

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LAKE COUNTY, FLORIDA; AMENDING THE LAKE COUNTY CODE, APPENDIX E, LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS; AMENDING CHAPTER II, ENTITLED "DEFINITIONS", TO CREATE A DEFINITION FOR THE TERM "MUSIC FESTIVAL"; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; PROVIDING FOR FILING WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Lake County Code contains provisions governing special events; and

WHEREAS, Lake County has increasingly become a destination for a variety of special events, including music festivals; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide a clear and concise definition of music festivals; and

WHEREAS, on the 7th day of August, 2013, the Planning & Zoning Board, in its capacity as the Local Planning Agency, considered this ordinance and recommended approval at a properly advertised public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") desires to amend Chapter II, entitled "Definitions", to create a definition for the term "music festival"; and

WHEREAS, on the 24th day of September, 2013, this Ordinance was heard at a public hearing before the Lake County Board of County Commissioners; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Lake County, Florida, that:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. Amendment. Chapter II, Lake County Code, Appendix E, Land Development Regulations, entitled "Definitions", shall be amended to read as follows:

Chapter II – Definitions.

Music Festival. An outdoor musical entertainment event that: (1) is the principal event on the site; and (2) involves the assembly of more than 500 people; and (3) operates for six (6) hours, or longer.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase or the Ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way effect the validity of the remaining portion of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Inclusion in the Code. It is the intent of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Lake County Code and that the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section", "article" or such other appropriate word or phrase in order to accomplish such intentions.

Section 5. Filing with the Department of State. The clerk shall be and is hereby directed forthwith to send a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Secretary of State for the State of Florida.


Section 6. Effective. This Ordinance shall become effective upon filing with the Secretary of State.
