

PROCLAMATION

Lake County Recycles Day 2008

WHEREAS, November 15 is the eleventh annual "America Recycles Day", which is a time for the nation to renew its commitment to recycling; and;

WHEREAS, November 15 is the eleventh annual "Florida Recycles Day" which is a time for Florida to maintain its commitment to recycling; and

WHEREAS, Lake County's recycling and energy-from-waste programs have reduced the volume of material entering the waste stream, thereby conserving natural resources, and reducing air and water pollution; and

WHEREAS, for recycling programs to be effective, markets must be developed for products that incorporate post-consumer materials in their manufacture, are reusable, or are designed to be recycled;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY The Board of County Commissioners of Lake County, Florida, that:

Section 1. The Lake County Board of County Commissioners does hereby proclaim November 15, 2008 to be "LAKE COUNTY RECYCLES DAY 2008" in Lake County.



Section 3. A copy of this Proclamation shall be spread upon the Minutes of this meeting.






