This four day course prepares participants to deliver FEMA's Intermediate ICS (ICS-300), Advanced ICS (ICS-400) and the ICS/EOC Interface Workshop (G-191). Participants must have a working knowledge of ICS through experience and training, be experienced in adult training, and agree to deliver the above mentioned ICS curricula.

In addition to the L-449 curricula, students will also receive the G-265 Basic Instructional Delivery Skills program. G-265 prepares the participant to assist with State delivered training and covers preparation, presentation, and evaluation skills. Students who successfully complete this course will receive the L-449 and G-265 certificates.
