

**LAKE COUNTY PUBLIC NOTICE
APPLICATION FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT
DISASTER RECOVERY ENHANCEMENT FUNDING**

The public is being notified that Lake County government is applying for \$93,982 of supplemental Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) disaster recovery funding through the Florida Department of Community Affairs (DCA), made available from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, for disaster recovery activities in areas affected by Tropical Storm Fay, for which the President declared a major disaster in 2008 under Title IV of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act.

The application proposes to add these supplemental dollars to the 2010 grant award received from the same grant program. The grant is to install a generator and related infrastructure at Spring Creek Elementary School, 44440 Spring Creek Road, Paisley, FL, 32767 to enable the facility to have an uninterruptable power source and serve as a primary shelter for the public during times of need. These supplemental dollars will cover any unanticipated project costs to ensure successful implementation of this project. Funds used must be in accordance with all state and federal program requirements.
