A RESOLUTION OF THE LAKE COUNTY COMMUNITY TRAFFIC SAFETY TEAM, SUPPORTING THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL SIDEWALK GRANT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR SIDEWALK LINK ON THOMAS AVENUE (FROM GRIFFIN TO MLK BLVD.)

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Florida has recognized the Lake County Community Traffic Safety Team (Lake County CTST) as the forum for the execution of the traffic Education, Enforcement, Engineering, and Emergency Services in Lake County; and


WHEREAS, the Lake County CTST supports Lake County Public Works Safe Routes to School Sidewalk Grant Application for Thomas Avenue sidewalk project (Thomas Avenue from Griffin to MLK Blvd, approx. 3,500 linear feet). The proposed sidewalk will be on the Westside of Thomas avenue and appropriate crosswalks at intersection of Thomas Avenue and Griffin Road; and

WHEREAS, the Thomas Avenue Sidewalk Project will provide sidewalk access from the apartments at MLK Blvd. and to exiting sidewalk on Griffin to the Carver Middle School; and

WHEREAS, the Lake County Department of Public Works wishes to facilitate the planning, development, and implementation of projects and activities that will improve safety and reduce traffic, fuel consumption, and air pollution in the vicinity of schools; and

WHEREAS, the Lake County CTST finds that this project will provide a safe passage for students who walk and bicycle along the Thomas Avenue corridor between Griffin and MLK Blvd.
