A RESOLUTION OF THE LAKE COUNTY COMMUNITY TRAFFIC SAFETY TEAM, SUPPORTING THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL SIDEWALK GRANT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE ORANGE AVENUE SIDEWALK PROJECT (FROM HASELTON TO CRICKET HOLLOW SUBDIVISION NORTH AND FRUITWOOD ON THE SOUTH)

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Florida has recognized the Lake County Community Traffic Safety Team (Lake County CTST) as the forum for the execution of the traffic Education, Enforcement, Engineering, and Emergency Services in Lake County; and

WHEREAS, the Lake County CTST supports Lake County Public Works Safe Routes to School Sidewalk Grant Application for the Orange Avenue sidewalk project (from Haselton to the Cricket Hollow Subdivision on the north and Fruitwood Ave. on the south). The proposed sidewalk will be on both the north and south sides of Orange Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Orange Avenue Sidewalk Project is on the Lake County School District's top 31 sidewalk lists and will benefit children walking to and from school; and

WHEREAS, the Lake County Department of Public Works wishes to facilitate the planning, development, and implementation of projects and activities that will improve safety and reduce traffic, fuel consumption, and air pollution in the vicinity of schools; and

WHEREAS, the Lake County CTST finds that this project will provide a safe passage for students who walk and bicycle along Orange Avenue corridor from Haselton to the Cricket Hollow Subdivision.
