A RESOLUTION OF THE LAKE COUNTY COMMUNITY TRAFFIC SAFETY TEAM, SUPPORTING THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL SIDEWALK GRANT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR SIDEWALK LINK ON ABRAMS ROAD (FROM N. DELLWOOD DRIVE TO WASHINGTON AVE.) IN EUSTIS

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Florida has recognized the Lake County Community Traffic Safety Team (Lake County CTST) as the forum for the execution of the Traffic Education, Enforcement, Engineering, and Emergency Services in Lake County; and


WHEREAS, the Lake County CTST supports Lake County Public Works Safe Routes to School Sidewalk Grant Application for Abrams Road Sidewalk Project (Abrams Road from N. Dellwood Drive to Washington Avenue, approx. 3,000-linear feet) ; and

WHEREAS, the Abrams Road Sidewalk Project will provide sidewalk access from the Eustis residential area to exiting sidewalk on Abrams Road to the Eustis Middle School ; and

WHEREAS, the Lake County Department of Public Works wishes to facilitate the planning, development, and implementation of projects and activities that will improve safety and reduce traffic, fuel consumption, and air pollution in the vicinity of schools; and

WHEREAS, the Lake County CTST finds that this project will provide a safe passage for students who walk and bicycle along the Abrams Road Corridor.
