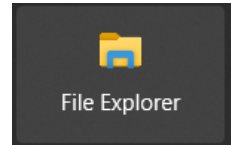

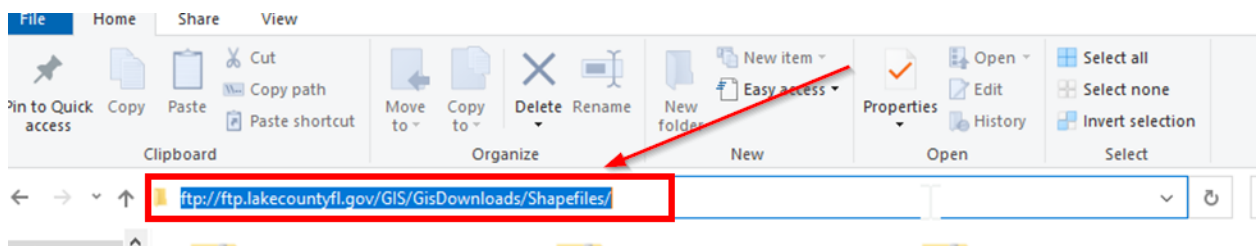
Using FTP Links in File Explorer

Recently Chrome and Edge pushed out an update that disabled FTP browsing in their browsers. This means that FTP links will not work. An error won't even display sometimes, it just does...nothing.

The quickest workaround is to use File Explorer



1. Click on the File Explorer in your Start Menu. You may even have a shortcut in your task bar.
2. Copy the FTP link you wish to open and paste it into the address bar of the File Explorer. You can also type in the FTP site in the address bar, as shown below.



3. Press Enter after typing or pasting the address.
4. You are now browsing the FTP space. You can access the file you need by dragging or copying them to your local machine. You can even open multiple windows to copy files to-and-from their original locations to the appropriate folders on the FTP site.
