1 Catholic Charities of Central Florida, Inc. Emergency Family Assistance Program	\$ 94,260.00	\$ 9,000.00	12	\$ 3,500.00	This program provides assistance to clients who are facing financial difficulties due to unexpected crisis situations. These requests may include basic needs, such as rent or mortgage payments, utility bills, car payments and/or repairs, insurance payments, taxes, school tuition, traffic tickets, fines, etc. These funds will be utilized for direct services to clients by providing financial help.
2 Community Primary Health Clinic Quick Medication Assistance Program	\$ 1,301,002.00	\$ 10,000.00	100	\$ 5,000.00	Once a patient is enrolled in the Prescription Assistance Program, it takes 3-4 weeks before the patient receives their medication. This program would provide medications for chronic conditions, such as high blood pressure, high cholesterol, diabetes and asthma/COPD during this wait period. These funds will be utilized for direct services to clients, with a \$5,000.00 cash match from Florida Waterman Hospital.
3 Deaf Service Center of Lake County, Inc. Case Management Services Program	\$ 23,860.00	\$ 10,000.00	48	\$ 8,000.00	This program serves clients which are deaf and/or hard of hearing. These funds will be utilized for direct services to these client by providing audiology (hearing screening & counseling), safety notification (equipment, such as visual doorbell signaler, visual smoke alarms, refurbished hearing aids and weather alert radio strobe lights).
4 FAITH Neighborhood Center, Inc. Utility Assistance Program	\$ 10,000.00	\$ 10,000.00	150	\$ 7,500.00	Provides utility assistance to eligible clients. These funds will be utilized for direct services to the client by making payments directly to the utility company on their behalf.
5 Lake Cares, Inc. Feed the Body and Educate the Mind	\$ 321,377.00	\$ 10,000.00	1,875	\$ 7,500.00	Provides food to those in need, such as the unemployed, elderly and disabled. These funds will be utilized for direct services to clients by providing fresh foods only, which is to include meat, eggs, margarine and fresh local produce.
6 Lake Community Action Agency, Inc. Family Self-Sufficiency Program	\$ 104,399.00	\$ 10,000.00	16	\$ 8,000.00	This program offers housing assistance to those in danger of becoming homeless. These funds will be utilized for direct services to clients by offering rental or mortgage assistance up to a maximum of \$500.00 per client.
7 New Vision for Independence, Inc. MOVING (Mobility and Orientation for Visually Impaired with Navigational Goals) Forward with New Vision	\$ 59,533.00	\$ 10,000.00	160	\$ 8,000.00	This program addresses the orientation and mobility needs of adults who are blind or have low vision. These funds will be utilized for direct services to clients by providing itinerant one-on-one instruction, independent living skills classes, family workshops and Visually Impaired Persons (VIP) support groups.
