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RESOLUTION NO. 2011 – 27

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LAKE COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING FEE SCHEDULES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010 - 2011 FOR SERVICES PROVIDED BY: THE DEPARTMENT OF GROWTH MANAGEMENT; DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY; DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC RESOURCES; DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION AND COMPLIANCE; OFFICE OF PROCUREMENT SERVICES; DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY SERVICES; DEPARTMENT OF FACILITIES DEVELOPMENT AND MANAGEMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, Section 125.01, Powers and Duties, grants the Board of County Commissioners of Lake County, Florida, the power to carry on county government which includes the authority to impose service fees; and

WHEREAS, in order to equitably distribute costs and expenses to the users of Lake County services, it is in the best interests of the residents of Lake County to adjust some of the current fees;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Lake County, Florida, that:

Section 1. This Resolution shall supersede all prior resolutions adopting fee schedules.

Section 2. **Department of Growth Management Fee Schedule.** The Fee Schedule for services provided by Administrative and Development Processing, the Planning and Community Design Division and the Building Services Division of the Department of Growth Management as set forth in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby adopted.

Section 3. **Department of Public Safety Fee Schedule.** The Fee Schedule for services provided by the Communications Technologies Division, Emergency Management Division, and Fire Rescue Division of the Department of Public Safety as set forth in Exhibit "B", attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby adopted.

Section 4. **Department of Public Resources Schedule.** The Fee Schedule for services

1 provided by the Library Services Division, Parks and Trails Division and Fairgrounds Division, as
2 set forth as Exhibit "C", attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby adopted.

3 **Section 5. Department of Public Works Fee Schedule.** The Fee Schedule for services
4 provided by the Engineering Division, Funding and Production Division, Road Operations Division
5 and Solid Waste Division of the Department of Public Works, as set forth as Exhibit "D", attached
6 hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby adopted.

7 **Section 6. Department of Conservation and Compliance Fee Schedule.** The Fee
8 Schedule for services provided by the Code Enforcement Services Division, Probation Services
9 Division, and Animal Services Division, as set forth as Exhibit "E", attached hereto and made a part
10 hereof, is hereby adopted.

11 **Section 7. Office of Procurement Services.** The Fee Schedule for services provided by
12 the Office of Procurement Services for countywide fees for copies of public records for the general
13 public, as set forth as Exhibit "F", attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby adopted.

14 **Section 8. Department of Community Services.** The Fee Schedule for services
15 provided by the Lake County Health Department and Public Transportation Division, as set forth in
16 Exhibit "G", attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby adopted.

17 **Section 9. Department of Facilities Development and Management.** The Fee
18 Schedule for services provided by the Facilities Management Division, as set forth as Exhibit "H",
19 attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby adopted.

20 **Section 10. Cost of Accepting Credit Cards and Debit Cards.** The State contract for
21 merchant services and Lake County Policy LLC-48 allows the County to charge a convenience fee on
22 credit card and debit card transactions to recoup the cost of providing these payment options to its
23 customers. A fee equal to 1% of the transaction total will be added to all transactions paid with a

1 credit card or debit card. This amount will be in addition to and added to the fees authorized in
2 Exhibits "A" through "H".

3 **Section 11. Sales Tax.** An appropriate amount of sales tax will be added to those fees that
4 are subject to sales tax per the Florida Statutes. This amount will be in addition to and added to the
5 fees authorized in Exhibits "A" though "H".

6 **Section 12. Waiving of Fees and Refunding of Fees.** The County Manager is authorized
7 to waive, refund, or partially refund the fees reflected in Sections 2 -9 above if the County Manager
8 determines that the fees are not necessary or were charged in error.


9 **Section 13. Effective Date of Fee Schedules.** The fees in Fee Schedules, Exhibits "A"
10 through "H", attached hereto shall remain in effect until replaced or superseded.


11 **Section 14. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.

1	No refund shall be given on any permits \$100 or less unless the permit is issued in error by the County.
2	No more than 50% of building, electrical, plumbing, fire, gas or mechanical fees shall be refunded.
3	No refund shall be given on plan review fees or administrative fees.
4	One-half of the permit fee is required at the time of application. This fee is non-refundable.
5	Refunds shall only be released to the property owner unless otherwise stated in written notarized notification from the property owner that the refund can be released to someone else.
6	No refund shall be given on permits over one hundred eighty (180) days old from date of issuance or if construction has been started unless the permit is issued in error by the County.
7	Building Permits shall become null and void if construction is not started and a valid inspection called for
8	There shall be an annual 3% increase on all charges except contractor licensing and minimum charges.
