RE: Recommendation for Population Projection Transmittal

On June 17, the Board of County Commissioners adopted BEBR low, as projected in Volume 41, Bulletin 150. Since this number is established already by BEBR and not a projection to be achieved by use of a local methodology, staff does not need to create a committee as was done in the past. The Florida Administrative Code (FAC) 9J-5.005 (2) (e), 1. only requires methodology when the local government chooses to prepare its own estimates and projections.

FAC 9J-5.005 (2) (e) states: "if the local government chooses to base its plan on either low or high range projections provided by the University of Florida or the Executive Office of the Governor, a detailed description of the rationale for such a choice shall be included with such projections."

Staff recommends that we transmit this action to the Department of Community Affairs (DCA) with the following rationale:

BEBR low population projections sufficiently accommodates the number of residents Lake County can support and ensure a high quality of life. For this reason, the Lake County Board of County Commissioners has adopted BEBR low.
