ITEM 1

Tani Marconnet & Nathaniel McNeil, SM-AS-160133484

Respondents were present and sworn.

Diana Johnson stated this case is charging the owner with violation of Section 4-27 "Nuisance Animals" and Section 4-28 "Attack or Bite to Persons and/or Animals". Staff recommended the Special Magistrate find the Respondent in violation of this section and impose a fine of \$2,650.00.

File was entered into evidence.

Officer Sharon Beardsley testified to the facts of the case.

Nikila Jemmott, complainant, was present, sworn and testified to the facts of the case.

Walter Salgado, complainant, was present, sworn and testified to the facts of the case.

Tani Marconnet testified to the facts of the case and admitted that dogs have been loose off of property before.

Special Magistrate Charles D. Johnson accepted staff's recommendation and granted 180 days to pay the fine.

ITEM 4

Rita Saunders & Mark McQuilling, SM-AS-160141505

Respondents were not present.

Diana Johnson stated this case is charging the owner with repeat violation of Section 4-27 "Nuisance Animals". Staff recommended the Special Magistrate find the Respondents in violation of this section and impose a fine of \$150.00.


File was entered into evidence.
