The Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grants (EECBG) Program, funded for the first time by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (Recovery Act) of 2009, represents a Presidential priority to deploy the cheapest, cleanest, and most reliable energy technologies we have - energy efficiency and conservation - across the country. The Program, authorized in Title V, Subtitle E of the Energy Independence and Security Act (EISA) and signed into law on December 19, 2007, is modeled after the Community Development Block Grant program administered by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). It is intended to assist U.S. cities, counties, states, territories, and Indian tribes to develop, promote, implement, and manage energy efficiency and conservation projects and programs designed to:

- Reduce fossil fuel emissions;
- Reduce the total energy use of the eligible entities;
- Improve energy efficiency in the transportation, building, and other appropriate sectors; and
- Create and retain jobs.

Through formula and competitive grants, the Program empowers local communities to make strategic investments to meet the nation's long-term goals for energy independence and leadership on climate change.

County's initial award obligated \$200,000.00 for preparation of an Energy Efficiency and Conservation Strategy.

preparation of an Energy Efficiency and Conservation Strategy (EECS) to include one or more eligible activities delineated in Funding Opportunity Announcement DE-FOA0000013. Lake County hired a consultant to assist with preparation of the EECS and it was completed and submitted to the Department of Energy (DOE) on November 18, 2009. Subsequently, the DOE requested additional information and modifications to the submitted EECS. The Energy Efficiency and Conservation Plan project activity is currently estimated at 85% complete. Lake County staff will continue to work with the consultant and DOE to gain final approval of the EECS and award modification in order to proceed with the project activities outlined in the EECS. On 12/1/09 Lake county requested a drawdown of \$79,880.00 for a pending payment to The Cadmus Group, the consulting firm contracted for preparation of the EECS. On 12/7/09, Lake County requested drawdowns from ASAP for county staff administrative costs for 143 hours in the amount of \$7530.12 and county staff direct costs for 146 hours in the amount of \$5379.77.
